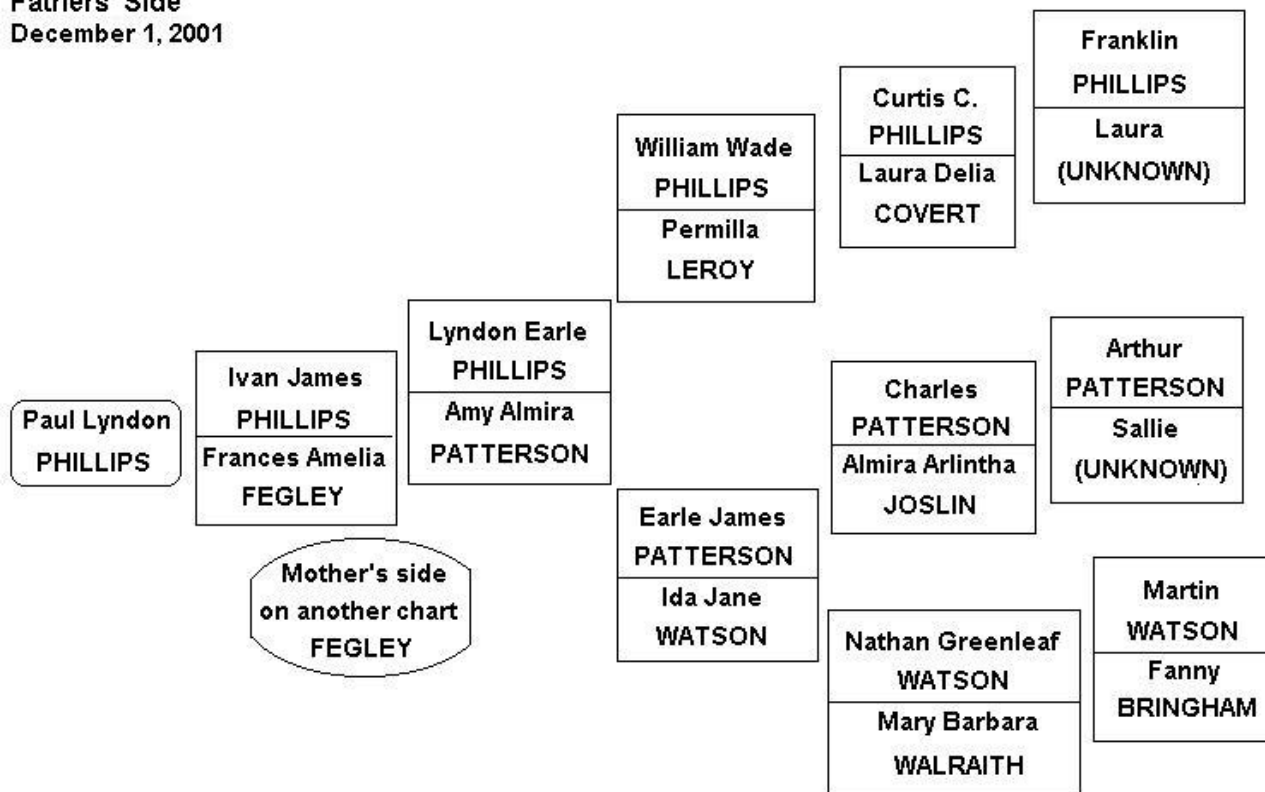

Paul Lyndon Phillips extended family. Ivan James Phillips, was my father and the son of Lyndon Earle Phillips, who was the son of William Wade Phillips, the son of the third child of Franklin and Laura Phillips, Curtis Cady Phillips

Hi Paul- Ok here goes--- Franklin Phillips b- 2/14/1806 -Mass. exact location still unknown. Laura Lovelefs (As written in the Phillips family bible that I found online in a rare book store in Owego NY- Sad that I had to buy a family heirloom) B-10/26/1806 in NY- location unknown. I at this time can not find any of her family. They married 12/28/1826- you think Phelps I assumed it was Sennett. Who knows. Laura is buried in the Old Sennett Cemetery- died 12/10/1851 at age 45 years 1 mo 15 days. Franklin was in Sennett,Cayuga Co NY at least by 1825. He was a farmer with approx 5 acres. He also dug graves for \$.

Curtis C B 6/13/1834- wife Laura married 1867- had 9 children

Elizabeth B 10/24/1838 - married ?? Bryant- Lived in Auburn NY Died 4/3/1917

Electa B 9/16/1842 - married Sydney Wright Carriage & Barrel maker in

Sennett D-9/25/1926

Roxanna B 5/19/1846 - married James Drake- Was a blacksmith- over the blacksmith was S>Wright's carriage shop. Children Franklin B1866 Charles B 1867 Eva B 1871. Eva was the teacher in the Sennett hamlet. Roxanna died 10/21/1914

Sydney died 7/21/1908

Franklin's second wife-- Susan A. Morgan B 8/23/1815 Franklin married Susan March 1852 . She worked as a domestic at Dr.Cady's home across the street from Franklin. Dr. Cady was also a gentleman farmer with approx. 50 acres. One of his farm hands that also resided in his home was Curtis Cady Phillips.

Charles A B 8/1/1852 d- 7/9/1853

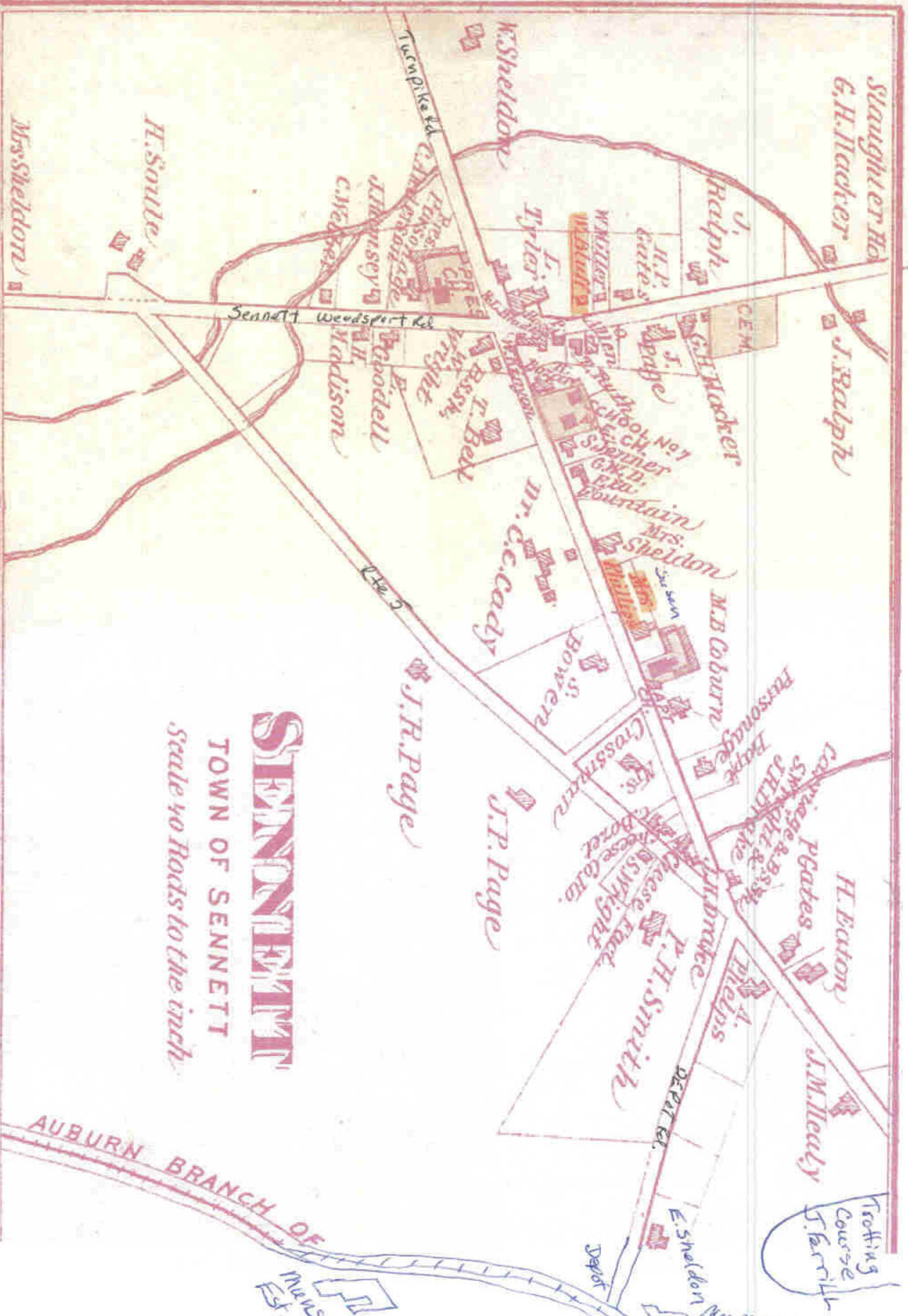
Laura B 4/25/1853 married Oscar D. Case- my gr gr grandparents- They lived across the street in Sennett where Franklin did live. The original house was torn down for a church- which is gone now.

Paul- Senica(as was spelled in bible) at age 20 works for Rich Howry (blacksmith) as a laborer. He was in the Civil War 97 NY Infantry- Rank in- Private Rank out- Corporal. Enlisted 7/22/1863 in Auburn NY promoted to Full Corporal 9/15/1864. Mustered out 7/18/1865- in the field in VA.The NY 97th was called Conkling Rifles. Fought in Manassas, South Mountain, Antietam, Frederickburg, Chancellorsville, Gettysburg, Spottsylvania, Cold Harbor, Petersburg, Hicksford Raid and Appomattox campaign. In 1870 Senica with wife Rachel and son Frank G (14) was ticket agent for Railroad in the hamlet of Sennett. In 1870 Elizabeth (sister) was a domestic at Joseph Fernal home in Sennett. In 1880 Senica wife Rachel and adopted daughter Christina lived next door to Susan Phillips. Senica was still the ticket agent for NY Central R.R.. In 1888 Senica fell on the tracks on the way home from work and shattered is ankle. As he was finally mending he had a massive hear attack and died.

One thing I am still planning on checking out is that Dr.Curtis Cady ( with son Dr. Cady) came to Sennett Ny in 1815 from Hinsdale, Mass. I will check out the location to see if there is any Phillips in the Area.

I have gone to both Sennett cemeteries and checked out the Hamlet of Sennett. There is no head stone for Franklin- but the cemetery people and myself assume he is buried with his first wife Laura. Susan is buried with Oscar & Laura Case in the Sennett Rural Cemetery about a mile from the Hamlet of Sennett. I keep saying the hamlet-- because within the Town of Sennett is the hamlet of Sennett . When I locate the rest of my info on the girls and their offspring I'll send it along . You see I have files and boxes for many, many, many families. I do this for family and friends when I have the time and energy. Also I am sending form that shows the Hamlet of Sennett in 1875 and where everyone lived and or worked. It's really neat.. Good night for now.
