



Coming into God's Presence with Swept Away Guilt.

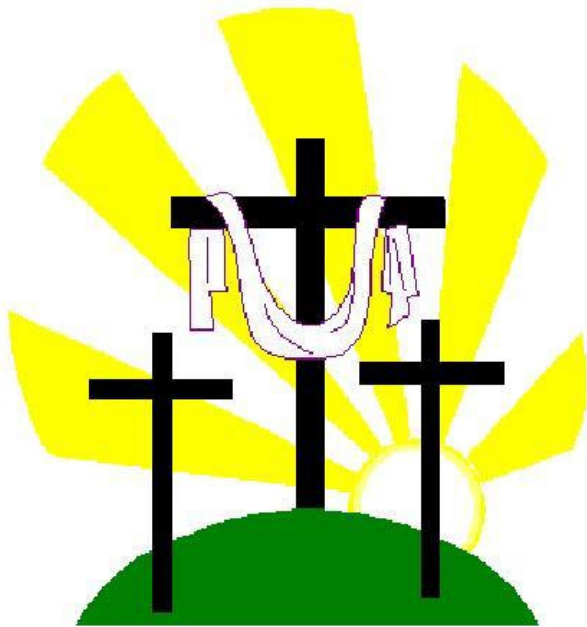
It is about one thirty in the morning, April 3, 2010.
